Lea Bregar, Doctor of Economics, Associate Professor at the University of Ljubljana. Until retirement, she taught courses on statistics and research methods at graduate, postgraduate and doctoral level at Faculty of Economics, Ljubljana. She has taken part and led several research projects on statistics, distance education and e-learning, and is the author of a number of articles, discussions and course books. In the years 1998 - 1999, she developed innovative online textbook on Economic Statistics in English and Slovenian. She has taken part in Slovene and international statistical and educational conferences and

meetings, and is a member of various international statistical/educational associations. After retirement, she took part as a team leader, key expert and trainer in several EU sponsored projects on development of official statistics in Croatia, Monte Negro, Ireland, Turkey, United Emirates. In this period, she also intensified her research and pedagogic work on e-learning. She carried out numerous trainings on e-learning for adults in cooperation with Slovenian institute for Adult education. She is the first author and editor of the two comprehensive books on e-learning (in Slovenian): E-learning principles (2010) and E-learning for digital society (2020). In the last decade, she has been cooperating with DOBA Faculty, the only online higher education institution in Slovenia with two international certifications: UNIQUe and EOCCS. She is a course leader of the two postgraduate courses (Management of e-learning; Innovative trends in education), mentor of graduate students and also head of the Research institute for e-learning. At DOBA Business School she designed and led several development projects aimed to enhance quality and innovate current online model at this institution. In the academic year 2019/2020 she participated in delivery of the course Open education design of master programme Leadership in open education at University of Nova Gorica, School of Engineering and Management, Slovenia. In 2021, she is involved as a mentor in the international online mentoring program OE4BW under auspices of Unesco supporting the development and implementation of open educational resources (OER) on issues related to sustainable development.
